**AMENDMENT OF DIRECTIONS ISSUED IN TERMS OF REGULATION 4(8) AND (10) OF THE REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 27(2) OF THE DISASTER MANAGEMENT ACT, 2002 (ACT NO. 57 OF 2002): MEASURES TO PREVENT AND COMBAT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19**

I, **Dr Pakishe Aaron Motsoaledi**, the Minister of Home Affairs, having issued Directions published in *Government Gazette* No. 45961, Government Notice No. 1800 of 25 February 2022, as amended, hereby issue the Directions set out in the Schedule in order to prevent and combat the spread of COVID-19.

**SCHEDULE****Definitions**

1. In these Directions, unless the context otherwise indicates—

**Substitution of paragraph 16 of the Directions**

2. The following paragraph is hereby substituted for paragraph 16 of the Directions:

**“16. OPENING AND CLOSURE OF SOME PORTS OF ENTRY**

16.1 All ports of entry at airports, except at Pilanesberg International Airport, will be opened with effect from the date of publication of these Directions in the *Gazette*.

16. 2 The closed ports of entry referred to in regulation 42(1) of the Regulations are as listed in Annexure "A".

16.3 A person traveling to and from the Republic who is from a neighbouring country or any other international traveller who is traveling to and from the Republic is allowed entry into, or exit from, the Republic subject to the prescribed screening procedures referred to in regulation 75(3) and (4)(c) of the Regulations."

**Short title and commencement**

4. These Directions are called the Fourteenth Amendment Directions to the Directions and commence on the date of publication in the *Gazette*.
