DISASTER MANAGEMENT ACT, 2002

AMENDMENT OF DIRECTIONS ISSUED IN TERMS OF REGULATIONS 4(7), 20(1) AND 20(2) OF THE REGULATIONS MADE UNDER SECTION 27(2) OF THE DISASTER MANAGEMENT ACT, 2002 (ACT NO. 57 OF 2002): MEASURES TO ADDRESS, PREVENT AND COMBAT THE SPREAD OF COVID-19 IN RAILWAY OPERATIONS

I, Fikile Mbalula, MP, the Minister of Transport, after consultation with the Cabinet members responsible for cooperative governance and traditional affairs, health, police and justice and correctional services, in terms of regulations 4(7), 20(1) and 20(2) of the Regulations issued in terms of the Disaster Management Act, 2002 (Act No. 57 of 2002), hereby amend the directions published under Government Notice No. 494, in *Government Gazette* No. 43273 of 4 May 2020, by the substitution for direction 13 of the following direction:

"13. Resumption of service

Gautrain	PRASA
<p>The Gautrain will resume its commuter services from—</p> <p>(i) Park Station to Hatfield station; and</p> <p>(ii) Sandton station to Rhodesfield station.</p>	<p>(1) PRASA commuter services will remain suspended during Alert Level 4.</p> <p>(2) During Alert Level 4, PRASA will focus on the maintenance, servicing and testing of its fleet, and will further sanitize and disinfect its stations and hubs in preparation for the resumption of its services. "</p>

This amendment comes into effect on the date of publication thereof in the Government Gazette.
